

Volunteer site stewardship training workshop Webinar **April 30, 2022**, 9:00 am to 3:00 pm

This training is the first day of a two-day workshop to train California volunteer site stewards. This free Zoom webinar lasts six hours, including a one hour lunch break. Although there is no cost, you must register at <www.cassp.org> starting March 11. Webinar contents include archaeological background, awareness of prehistoric and historic resources, safety first, and legal protections for archaeology.

The second day of the workshop will be held for those who attend this webinar. It's an in-person, small group, field training. It will be scheduled during the following weeks, as conditions allow, at Los Padres National Forest and at Cleveland National Forest. The second day also requires a separate registration, signed confidentiality agreement concerning site locations, and a \$25 fee.
