Volunteer site stewardship online training workshop on November 22, 2025, 9:00 to 3:00

This online session is the first day of a two-day workshop to train California volunteer site stewards. It's a free Zoom meeting that lasts six hours, including a one hour lunch break. Although there is no cost, you must register by sending your contact information to Beth Padon at bpadon@sitestewardship.org. This meeting will present information about volunteering as a site steward, as well as information about archaeology in California, awareness of prehistoric and historic resources, safety, legal protections for archaeology, and Native American concerns. Archaeologists from California State Parks will present information about their resource areas.

The second day of the workshop is an in-person, small group, field training that will be offered to those who attended the first day of this or earlier online meetings. It will be scheduled after the holidays in early 2026, with exact dates depending on funding and availability of agency archaeologists. The second day requires a separate registration, a signed confidentiality agreement concerning sensitive site locations, and a \$25 fee payable to Partners for Archaeological Site Stewardship.
